WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Couples who share a household or couples who are permanent dance partners and live in 2 households are allowed to participate.

Even if you have mild symptoms (e.g. fever, dry cough, breathing problems, loss of taste and / or smell, sore throat, body aches), please definitely stay at home. Even people who have had contact with people who tested positive for Sars-Cov-2 in the past 14 days are not allowed to attend classes.

THE PROCESS IN THE STUDIO:

Please wear mouth and nose protection outside of the classroom and observe the usual distance rules and keep the distance despite the joy of seeing you again.

Please arrive no more than 10 minutes before the start of the lesson in order to avoid overlapping with the participants of the previous course in the studio and stairwell.

Please change your shoes in the dance room and use the chairs at the two-seat tables for your jackets.

For activities with increased breathing air emissions, a distance of 2.50 m is required, which must be observed in the dance room. To ensure this, we have marked the floor in the dance room accordingly. Changes of dance partners will still not take place (not even in small groups). Teachers give corrections, help and tips in class only verbally.

We ventilate the rooms regularly, so it could be a little cooler. Bring something warmer to wear.

You will find disinfection facilities in the foyer.

Access to the toilets is regulated by a traffic light system (Light off: free, light on occupied).

During these times, the studio is cleaned and aired several times and regularly.

Handles, handrails and surfaces are also disinfected more frequently.

We are obliged to document your presence. In order to trace any chains of infection, we have to keep the lists for 4 weeks so that we can present them to the competent authority upon request.

We will carefully store this data and delete it again after this period has expired.

By participating in classes and dancing at La Yumba, you declare that you agree to these rules.

We look forward to seeing you again. All of this is just as unfamiliar to us as it is to you and we do not want to overreact or be too lax with the situation. But it will only work if we all follow the rules.

We are confident that we will treat each other with understanding and together make the best and most beautiful of it. Finally we're dancing again!
